Overview

Leadership Central Penn, a program of The Foundation of the Columbia Montour Chamber of Commerce, began in 1993. LCP seeks to identify and educate citizens from Columbia and Montour counties that exhibit leadership potential. This program provides:

- An understanding of the services available in our community including education, health care, government, media and cultural activities.
- Knowledge of volunteer opportunities in our community, leading to board appointments and positive exposure for sponsoring businesses.
- Professional development including organizational leadership, problem solving, multigenerational management, and much more.

Dates

The LCP classes typically meet on the 3rd Thursday of each month for a full day (approx. 8:30 to 4:30) from September through May.

Cost

The program cost will be \$995 per participant. Most participants are sponsored by their employers. Some partial and full scholarships will be available for employees of non-profit organizations. There is a No Refund policy.

Application

Area businesses and organizations are encouraged to nominate and sponsor employees. Individuals may also apply. Applications are available at the office of the Columbia Montour Chamber of Commerce at 238 Market St. in Bloomsburg or you can download an application at the Chamber Foundation's website at www.cmccfoundation.com.

The application deadline is July 31st. Participants will be selected by August 15th.
